Dress Code

While the student dress is a matter of individual taste, there is an appropriate standard of dress/accessories required while at school. School is a special building with a very important function – learning! The following list has been established by staff members and administration and identifies inappropriate dress/accessories for school. As new trends in dress are often an ongoing issue, this dress code will be reviewed on an ongoing basis. Changes to the dress/accessories code will be communicated to the student body as required.

1. Coats and jackets are not to be worn in class.
2. Backpacks are to be left in your locker. They are not to be brought to class.
3. Sweatbands and bandanas are not to be worn in the building.
4. MP3 players, iPods, and cell phones are not to be heard by anyone else while in class.
5. Cell phones **MUST** be set to vibrate while in class.
6. There will be **NO** use of headphones or cell phones during quizzes, tests or exams.
7. Bare midriffs are **NOT** permitted. Shirts, blouses, t-shirts must be long enough to cover the student's midriff. The top touches the waistband.
8. Clothing with studs (including collars, wristbands, finger accessories and pocket chains) are not to be worn.
9. Clothing with holes, torn off sleeves, or inappropriate pictures and /or messages is not to be worn.
10. Tank tops, tube tops and mesh tops are not appropriate clothing for school. Sleeveless tops should have straps of at least 6 cm. in width. (**3 fingers**)
11. Shorts and skirts must be suitable in length to the tips of your fingers when extended at your sides.
- 12. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be asked to leave.**
